- Catherine Vannier, France, who lost her seventeen year old daughter in the Cairo bombing, on the 22nd of February 2009;
- Mélanie Berthouloux, France, who was wounded during the Cairo bombing, on the 22nd of February 2009;
- Angeles Pedraza, Spain, who lost her daughter during the 11th of March, 2004 bombing, in Madrid, she is also vice-president of AVT (Spain);
- Nathalie Fustier, France, a survivor of the bombing against the UN offices in Bagdad, on the 19th of August 2003, she is also president of AfVT;
- Special quest: John Frank Pinchao Blanco, Colombia, who was apprehended on the 1st of November 1998, he was detained for more than eight years as prisoner of the FARC, until his escape;
- Michael Gallagher, Northern Ireland, his brother was killed in an IRA ambush the 3rd of June, 1984, and his 21 year old son was killed during the Omagh bombing on the 15th of August 1998;
- Cherifa Kheddar, Algeria, the sister of two victims assassinated on the 24th of June 1996: her 34 years old sister was a lawyer and her 36 years old brother was an architect, she is also President of "Djazairouna", the association of Victims of Islamist Terrorism Families, in Algeria, member of the AICT;
- Danièle Klein, France, who lost her brother during the bombing of the UTA DC10 flight, on the 19th of September 1989;
- Adrien Mbouandji, Republic of Congo, who lost two brothers, four nephew and niece and a sister in law during the bombing of the UTA DC10 flight, on the 19th of September 1989;
- Pamela White, Great-Britain, former "bobby", was wounded during the IRA bombing in London, on the 17th of December 1983;
- Giorgio Bazzega, Italy, who's father has been victim of the terrorist Walter Alasia, a member of the Red Brigade, on the 15th of December 1976;
- Nicole Guiraud, France, was seriously wounded during the bombing of the "Milk-Bar", in Alger, on the 30th of September 1956.
